A short business meeting to review the past year and to elect officers for the coming year will begin at 11:30 a.m.

Our speaker will be Bobby LeFebre, Colorado's eighth and current poet laureate. Governor Polis appointed Bobby in July 2019 to a four-year term, saying that he "embodies the spirit of a 'Colorado for All,' where everyone is included, no matter their background." Bobby is a two-time Grand Slam Champion, a National Poetry Slam Finalist, an Individual World Poetry Slam Finalist, and a two-time TEDx speaker. He attended North High School, Metropolitan State University of Denver, and the University of Denver. His 2019 play *Northside* had 30 sold-out performances at Su Teatro.

The cost of the lunch will be \$35.00 and will feature an Italian buffet (mixed green salad, meatballs and Italian sausage, penne pasta with marinara sauce, tortellini with Alfredo sauce, vegetable medley, and tiramisu for dessert). As always, guests are welcome!
